Different types of birds on the basis of their claws.

4. Swimming Birds

- Birds which can swim in water are called swimming birds.
- Birds like ducks, and pelicans have webbed feet with three toes in front and one at the back.
- These webbed feet help them to swim.
- The front toes, in case of swimming birds are joined by skin giving them a flat appearance.
- They use their feet to paddle and push the water while swimming.



5. Running Birds

- Birds which have long and strong legs to run very fast are called as running birds.
- Running birds are flightless birds.
- Examples of running birds are Ostriches, Emus, and



Rheas.

- Ostriches are the fastest running birds in the world.

6. **Wading Birds**

- Birds like cranes, and herons have thin, long legs with widespread toes for wading through water.
- These toes keep the feet from sinking in the soft mud.
- These birds are known as Wading Birds.
