FAMILY

- A family is a group of two or more persons related by birth, marriage, or adoption who live together; all such related persons are considered as members of one family.
 - Every person is a part of a family.
 - A family is two or more people who are connected by biology, adoption, marriage, or strong emotional bonds.
 - Families can look very different from each other, but all family members usually love and care for each other very much.
- **Relationship:** It is a particular type of connection existing between people related to or having dealings with each other. An example of relationship is a brother and his sister.

Different kinds of families

We know that our parents and siblings are our immediate family and other relative who do not live with us are our extended family.

There are different kinds of families:

1. Nuclear family.
2. Joint family.
3. Single-parent family.

Nuclear family: A unit in which father, mother and children live together. Children come into families in different ways. Some children are born into a family. Other children are adopted.

Adoption is when a person who is not the child's biological parent is awarded legal parental rights to the child.

Joint family: A unit in which parents, children, grandparents and other relative live together. All members of a joint family live under one roof, and form one single household. a joint family is larger in size, since it consists of three generations living together.

Single-parent family: A family in which children live either with their mother or father.
