ROUND 1:

1. The first round of competition will start from Wednesday, 18.08.2021. This is an open round where all the students from Nursery can participate.
2. For this round, students can prepare all the '**COLOR RHYMES**' taught to them via online sessions. (Videos of these rhymes are available at school You tube channel for practice)

3. Students will share the video of their performance to the respective homerooms by or before 4:00pm on 18.08.2021. Please be noted that no video will be accepted after the stipulated time of submission for any reason.

4. The participants will be assessed on the following points:

- Presentation (Action, expression and introduction)
- Memory
- Pronunciation
- Confidence

5. The top ten videos from each section will be shortlisted for 2nd round.

6. The guidelines for the next round will be shared by the homeroom teacher via online classes and will be uploaded on school website too.
