Snake Bites

An injury caused by a bite from a snake can be life threatening if the snake is venomous. A bite by a venomous snake may be serious depending on the size of the victim, the location of the bite ,the amount of venom injected. Some venom produce direct toxic effects, but not all of them are lethal to human beings.

First aid for snake bite

In case of snake bites, we should follow the below mentioned tips:

1. Note the time of the bite.
2. Keep calm and still as movement can cause the venom to travel more quickly through the body.
3. Make the victim lie still as any movement causes the poison to spread faster in the blood
4. Take the victim to the doctor immediately for treatment.
