**Q 1 : Write a short note on the structure of the Panchayati Raj .**

**Ans: The Panchayati Raj works at three levels;**

**1. Gram Panchayat ;**

**It is at the village level.**

**2. Block Samiti ;**

**A group of villages come to form a block.It looks after the development of the block.**

**3. Zila Parishad ;**

**It is the highest body at the district level and looks after the whole district.**

**Ans: The Zila Parishad acts as a link between the State government and the bodies working at the block and village level.It helps the Gram Panchayats and the Block Samitis in development work in their respective areas.It also informs the State government about the work being done by them and advises the said government on all matters related to the development of the district.**
