At the grocery Store



On the first day of month January, Manoj went shopping for the grocery items along with his mother. They decided to get some vegetables, fruits and pulses for their kitchen pantry. So, they went shopping in a supermarket where they saw pulses, fresh fruits and vegetables. Manoj got a trolley and started shopping with his mother. Initially, they went to the pulses section where they saw various pulses and decided to buy some of them, so Manoj's mother (Savita) told Manoj to check the cost of the green dal (moong dal). Manoj replied that the cost of 1 kg packet is ₹ 80, his mother instructed him to keep 2 packets of moong dal in the trolley after that his mother decided to get some rajma dal as that is the favourite dal of Manoj's Father and Manoj. So, after checking the cost of 1 kg packet of rajma dal Manoj told his mother that its cost is ₹ 105. So, Savita told Manoj to take 4 packets of rajma dal, furthermore, they took 1kg packet of masoor dal which amounts to ₹ 55.

Now, they decided to get some fresh fruits, so they took their trolley towards the fruit section where they saw many fresh fruits. They took **2** dozen bananas (cost of **1** dozen bananas ₹ **25**) they also brought a watermelon of **5kg** (cost of **1kg** of watermelon ₹ **35**) and then they took **3** dozen oranges (cost of **1** dozen oranges ₹ **75**).



Moving ahead, they took their trolley towards the vegetable section, wherein, they took **3kg** of tomatoes (cost of **1kg** tomato ₹ **40**) then they also took **2 kg** of green spinach (cost of **1kg** spinach ₹ **55**). After that Manoj told his mother to buy some potatoes as he wanted to have potatoes for dinner along with peas. So, his mother took **3 kg** potatoes (cost of **1kg** potato is ₹ **25**) and she also took **2 kg** peas (cost of **1kg** pea's ₹ **45**).

After that, both Manoj and his mother decided to get slippers for the washroom. They saw that the cost of one slipper is ₹ **175** and then they decided to buy **2** slippers.

Also, Manoj wanted to buy some crayons and a drawing book, so his mother took **2** drawing books and a packet of crayons. (Cost of drawing book ₹ **50** and cost of crayons ₹ **110**). They also bought a shirt for Manoj's father (cost of shirt ₹ **780**).



Eventually, after 3 hours they completed the shopping. They waited in line at the checkout counter to pay money for the commodities they purchased. The cashier prepared their bill. They paid the bill and left the supermarket happily.
