Ensuing to G.O No 15-JK(DMRR) of 2022 of dated 13/02/2022 and G.O.No72- JK(Edu of 2022 dated 16.02.2022 of the Government of the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir for the reopening of the schools in the Union Territory of J&K with the following conditions and instructions:

In continuing with our efforts to start physical classes in the school, we are pleased to announce that the school will reopen from 28th February , 2022 , We understand the importance of returning to school for our children's education, and we will make certain that all students can do so safely. We are committed to assisting our children in returning to school and providing the high-quality curriculum, co-curricular, and extra -curricular programmes that distinguish the Goenkan education. While the probability of children being seriously ill as a result of coronavirus is low, we will continue to maintain social distancing and infection control measures based on the results of the essential risk assessments, to keep all members of our school community safe.

Grades: IX-XI Reopening Date: 28-02-2022

Physical classes shall commence from **Monday 28th February, 2022.** The students will have to attend the school daily.

Timings: 10:00 A.M. to 03:00 P.M.

KG- Grade VIII Reopening Date: 03-03-2022

Physical classes for these grades shall commence from **Thursday 3rd March**, **2022**. The students will attend school on alternate days. Parents will be informed shortly the days assigned to their wards.

Group – 1 – Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays

Group - 2 - Tuesdays, Thursdays, Saturdays

Timings: 10:00 A.M. to 03:00 P.M.

Cases involving siblings will be given careful consideration.

Nursery and L.KG

The **physical classes** for these grades shall commence from Wednesday 09-03-2022 **on alternative days.** Early release flexible arrangements will be made and shared with parents separately. Parents will have to pick and drop their wards till 12th March 2022 to make their little children comfortable and familiar with regular school environment.

Group - 1 - Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays

Group – 2 – Tuesdays, Thursdays, Saturdays

COVID APPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR POLICY OF THE SCHOOL (CAB).

Students aged 15 and older will be permitted to attend classes only after submitting a vaccination report. Students of all the above mentioned classes shall only be permitted to attend physical lessons after the submission of **NO OBJECTION/CONSENT LETTER** by the parents of the student in the format uploaded on website. The consent forms must be submitted in the school on the day of joining. No student shall be permitted to attend physical lessons without the written consent of the parents.

- All students attending physical lessons must be in full winter school uniform.
- The maximum strength per section will be such that the physical distance can be can be ensured.
- Children are advised to have their dry snacks and a lunch to be brought with them.

Arrival & Dispersal

- All students, whether they arrive with their parents/guardians or on their own, will be
 received at the main gate. No entry of any vehicle or parents/guardians will be permitted
 beyond the Main Gate during reporting and leaving time.
- Parents will not be allowed to enter the campus beyond the Main Gate during reporting and leaving time.
- Parents who drop their children at school on their own are advised to follow the assigned timings only to reduce the traffic congestion in front of the school.
- The duly filled 'Declaration by Parent' will be collected from the accompanying parent/guardian/student.
- Parents will ensure that they are wearing mask and sanitize their hands.
- Students will sanitize their hands as they enter the main gate.
- While entering and leaving the school, all of the school's gates will be opened for students.
- Classrooms near the gates and stairs will use the gates and steps closest to them.
- Different lanes will be designated for entering and exiting.

- Staff will be stationed at various locations to ensure that pupils maintain correct social distance and discipline when entering and exiting the school.
- As limited number of students shall attend in each shift, they must line up before the
 commencement of lessons, with supervised social distancing and for compulsory thermal
 scanning. If there is any indication of raised temperature, the student shall be immediately
 segregated and the parents shall be informed to take their ward home immediately. The
 student shall not be permitted to return for physical classes until a negative test report for
 COVID -19 is submitted by the designated authority.

In The Best Interest of Health Safety It Is Compulsory For Students To:

- Wear face masks at all the times.
- Carry a small sanitizer bottle for personal use.
- Carry their own water bottle
- Lunch box
- Gloves for added protection.
- Exchange of books, tiffin's or shaking hands is strictly prohibited.
- No child suffering from cold, cough and fever is to be sent to school.
- In case any family member is COVID positive, the child should not be sent to School.

TIME TABLE

- The class time table shall be arranged for comfortable transition of the teaching learning
 process every alternate day with support work to be completed the next day when students
 are working at home, tentatively till further directions.
- Children are expected to carry written material only, which should not be shared in the interest of health safety.
- Students will not be allowed to carry mobile phones within the campus.

THE SCHOOL'S AWARENESS OF PREVENTIVE MEASURES

- The school will display posters /charts / bulletin boards which will include the following message
- Proper and regular hand washing techniques
- Correct use of mask, which should cover nose, mouth and chin.
- · Maintaining a consistent social distance .
- Coughing or sneezing into our elbow.
- Spitting is prohibited.
- No sharing of food items or any other material.

SAFETY NORMS INSIDE THE CLASSROOM

- There will be sufficient space between each seat, and sitting arrangements for pupils will be clearly specified.
- Teachers will make certain that students sit in designated seats.
- Masks must be worn at all times by students.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided in each classroom.
- Textbooks, notebooks, stationery, tiffin boxes, water bottles, and other materials shall not be shared among students.

SAFETY NORMS INSIDE THE SCHOOL BUSES:

- Before permitting pupils to enter the buses, they will be sanitized on a daily basis.
- Every bus will have a hand sanitizer.
- Before kids board the bus, they will be subjected to a thermal examination. If a child is
 found to have high temperature, he or she will not be allowed to board the bus and will be
 sent home instead.
- Inside the buses, the children will be instructed to maintain a social distance. This can be accomplished by just allowing one student to sit in each seat.

For Re-Assurance of Parents, the Following Needs Are To Be Kept In Mind

- All classrooms used by students shall be sanitized before the students enter.
- To avoid physical contact between considerable numbers of children, there shall be no assembling of children.
- Proper inflow of air in the indoor places will be ensured.
- Sanitizers shall be available in the public areas in addition to the personal sanitizers compulsorily carried by each student.
- Hand washes shall be available in the lavatories.
- Furniture in classrooms has been arranged to ensure a minimum of six feet distance in the seating of each student.
- Students and staff members are to maintain social distance while walking or sitting.
- Proper social distance procedure shall be followed in staff rooms, offices areas and interaction places across the school.
- All students shall be sensitized about the spread of COVID- infection and the measures to
 prevent it. It is being brought to your kind notice again that present steps are taken to
 gradually resume all physical classes.
- All reasonable precautions, as given above, shall be enforced.
- Parents are advised not to enter school premises at reporting and leaving time of students.
 Entry of parents will be after proper verification of their ID's and CAB.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PARENTS.

Please do not send your child to school if they have:

- Fever
- Body discomfort
- Cough
- Respiratory illness
- Loose motion
- If any family member is experiencing COVID-19-related symptoms or is currently positive for COVID-19.

Getting a vaccine, wearing a mask, and maintaining social distancing remain our best means of protection.
