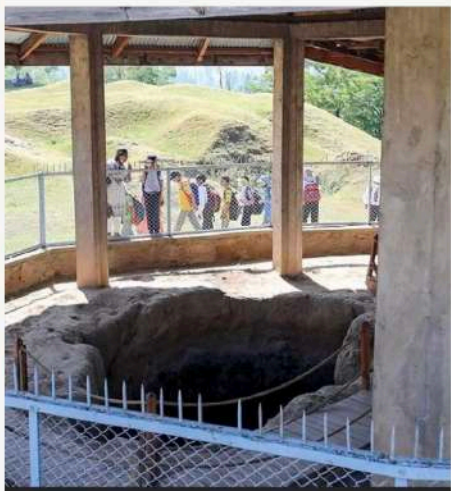


ahom is a very important historical monument.
