

To mark this beautiful day Grade 1 and Grade 2 Goenkans, on (14 November 2023.Tuesday) in their colourful dresses showcased various performances.












It included dancing, singing, Kashmiri Rouf, Skits and other Musical and cultural performances.








#### GD Goenka Takes a Stand on World Diabetes Day: Raising Awareness and Promoting Health in the School Community













Participation was open to parents and teachers through a free registration process. Around one


hundred and fifty participants created and displayed their works. Humanity needs a happy childhood. Please check the detailed documentation of the event ART FOR PEACE.


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
