Mental Health Awareness Sessions at GD Goenka Srinagar In consonance with World Mental Health Awareness Week. observed globally from 4th to 10th October, GD Goenka Srinagar organized a comprehensive two-day Mental Health Awareness Programme aimed at promoting emotional well-being among students and teachers. The initiative sought to highlight the significance of mental wellness as a cornerstone of holistic education and to nurture confident, selfaware, and emotionally resilient individuals.

The first day commenced with a Special Mental Health Assembly presented by the enthusiastic students of Grade V, attended by learners from Grades I–V. The young Goenkans participated wholeheartedly through expressive performances, poems, and reflections centered on the theme of emotional health. The session was further carried forward by Ms. Mehak, the Junior School Counsellor, who delivered an insightful speech on understanding emotions and expressing them constructively. She emphasized that the school, along with its teachers, serves as a safe and supportive space where students can approach them freely with any concern, big or small.
