in every uncertain moment.

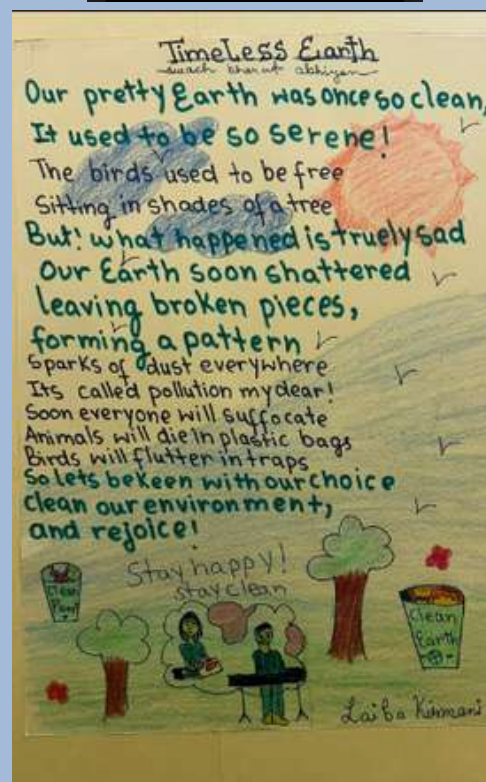
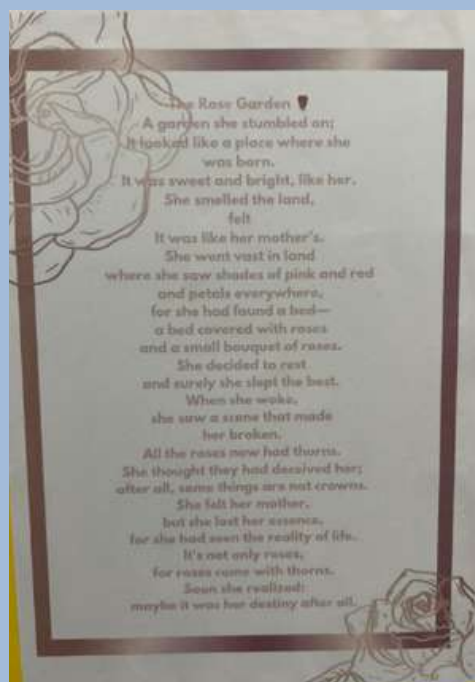
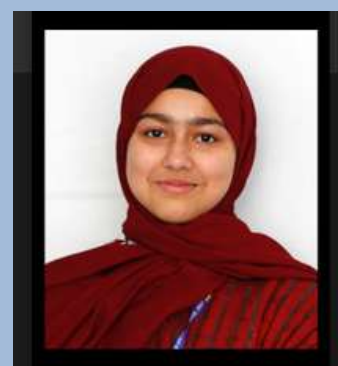

## Celebrating Creativity and Scientific Excellence

### Celebrating Innovation:

#### Our Journey Through Inspire & Vikshit Bharat Projects

This year has been an inspiring chapter for our Science Department as our students enthusiastically engaged in hands-on innovation through the INSPIRE Awards and Vikshit Bharat initiatives. Guided by curiosity and a passion for problem-solving, our young scientists explored real-world challenges and transformed their ideas into working models that reflect creativity, practicality, and social usefulness.

Among our proud entries was the Smart Time Table, an automated scheduling assistant designed to streamline daily routines for both students and teachers. Our students also engineered a Smart Hen Coop, which ensures better hygiene, controlled lighting, and improved safety for poultry through sensor-based automation.

Energy conservation and alternative methods of power generation were highlighted through projects like the Foot-Powered Pressure Plate, which demonstrates how everyday movement can be converted into usable energy, and the Laser-Powered Sound Visualizer, a fascinating device that converts sound vibrations into light patterns, making invisible sound waves visible.

To support sustainable living, our students also created practical household innovations such as the Self-Drinking Cup, designed to assist individuals with limited mobility, and a Smart Irrigation System, which conserves water by automatically supplying only the required amount based on soil moisture levels. Completing the lineup was the Smart Cloth Line, an automated solution that protects clothing from unexpected weather by retracting when it senses rainfall.

Each of these projects reflects the hard work, teamwork, and scientific spirit of our young innovators. Their dedication shows that when creativity meets scientific thinking, the possibilities are limitless. We look forward to nurturing more such ideas and contributing to a brighter, smarter, and more sustainable future for our nation.

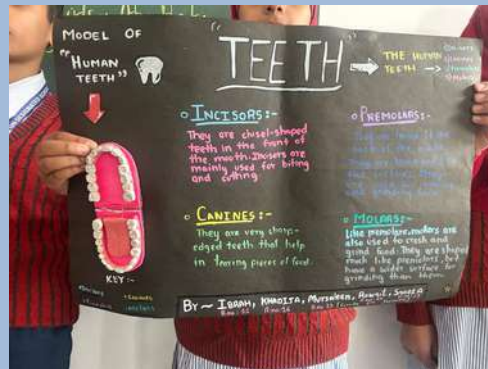
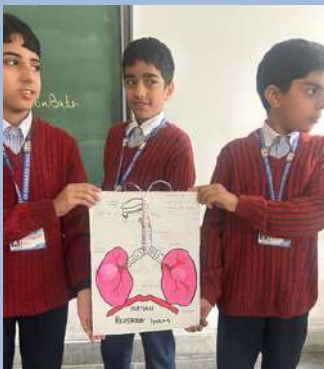
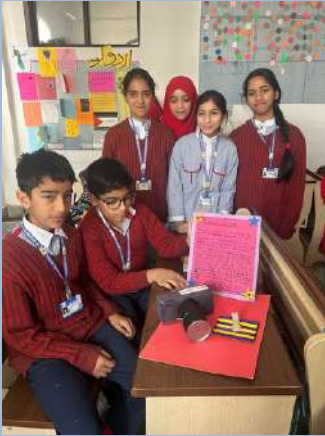

## Grade 7

"Grade 7 students, guided by their Science teachers, showcased impressive and well-crafted science models, highlighting creativity, and hands-on learning

## 1. Terrarium Project - Miniature

## Closed Ecosystem

A beautifully crafted terrarium showcases layers of pebbles, soil, moss, and delicate plant cuttings arranged inside a sealed glass jar. This student project demonstrates the concept of a self-sustaining ecosystem, where moisture recycles within the container and plants thrive in a controlled mini-environment. It highlights ecological balance, the water cycle, and the importance of green habitats, offering a practical model of environmental science.



## 2. Comic Strip - The Amazing Journey of Droppy the Water Drop

In a creative and educational comic strip, a student illustrates "Droppy," a cheerful water droplet, as he travels through the human excretory system. The comic explains complex biological processes in a child-friendly manner, following Droppy from absorption in the intestines to filtration in the kidneys, movement through nephrons, and finally his exit through the urethra. The project blends science with storytelling, making human physiology engaging and easy to understand.



## 3. Herbarium Sheet - Cheeseweed (Malva parviflora)

A student-created herbarium sheet showcases a carefully dried and preserved leaf of Cheeseweed (Malva parviflora), belonging to the Malvaceae family. The sheet records key scientific details, including the plant's name and date of collection (19/5/25).



This project demonstrates the student's understanding of plant documentation and highlights the importance of herbariums in botanical study, conservation, and education.

## 4. Indigenous Tribes Model

Students created an impressive 3D representation showcasing the lifestyle, culture, and environment of various indigenous tribes. The model highlighted tribal housing, traditional attire, and their deep connection with nature. This activity helped students appreciate cultural diversity and understand the importance of preserving tribal heritage.



**5. Nephron – Excretory System Model**

A detailed 3D nephron model was prepared to demonstrate the structure and working of the functional unit of the kidney. Students learned about filtration, reabsorption, and urine formation through clearly labeled parts such as the glomerulus, Bowman's capsule, and loop of Henle. This hands-on project deepened their understanding of human excretion.

**6. Simple Electric Circuit**

Students constructed a simple electric circuit using a cell, wires, switch, and bulb. Through this model, they explored the concept of open and closed circuits and understood how electric current flows. The activity strengthened their basic knowledge of electricity and its practical applications.

**7. Layers of the Earth Model**

To explore Earth's internal structure, a colourful 3D cross-section model was created by the students. The crust, mantle, outer core, and inner core were clearly distinguished, helping learners visualize and understand the layers beneath the Earth's surface.

**8. Pythagoras Theorem Model**

Using an innovative house-and-ladder setup, students demonstrated the Pythagoras theorem in a real-life context. The model illustrated how the base, perpendicular, and hypotenuse relate through the formula  $a^2 + b^2 = c^2$ . This creative representation made the mathematical concept easier and more engaging.

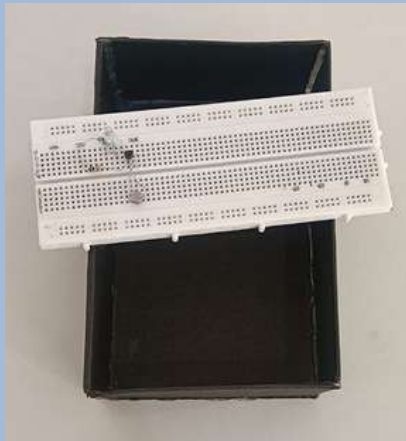

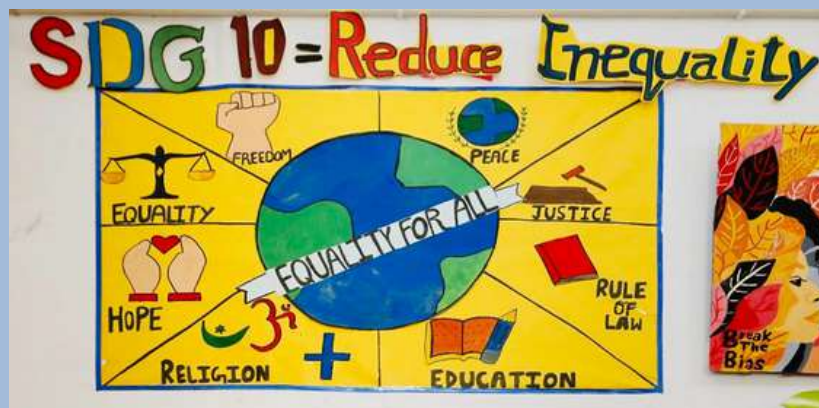

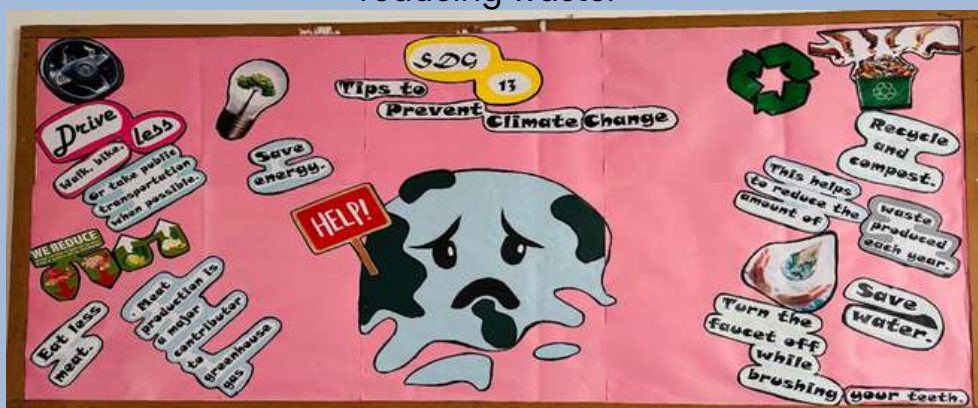
