### **GUIDELINES FOR PERIODIC TEST-II ( PT-II) 2026**

- The Periodic Test-II for the academic year 2026 will begin on 24 -08 -26
- The exam will be held in accordance with the above-mentioned schedule.
- Examination will be held daily, there will be no preparation holiday between consecutive paper, apart from the State holidays, as the weightage of paper is just 20 marks for primary school and 30 marks for grades VI through XII.
- Examination will be conducted during the zero period. Regular classes will commence after the examination.

- The marking scheme for the periodic test will be as mentioned below:  
Grades III –Grade V: 20 marks  
Grade VI onwards: 30 marks
- The students need to refer to notebooks, textbooks, worksheets, and other related materials relevant to the topics mentioned for the preparation of examinations.
- Only pen, pencil, eraser, ruler and the writing board are allowed in the examination room.
- Resorting to any malpractice will result in disqualifying the student from the examination and lead to disciplinary action.
- Copying from other students, talking or discussing in the examination hall, moving around leaving one's seat, possessing chits or other items will be treated as malpractices in the examination.
- Under no circumstance a retest will be conducted. **Examination dates will not be changed for one or few students.** However, in case of unavoidable situation like a shut down in the valley etc., examination dates will be rescheduled by the school authorities.
- **Absence from the examination will not be permitted except under serious medical condition**, which is to be approved by the Principal for which medical records are to be produced and no examination will be conducted but the tabulation of results will be based on the internal assessments and evaluations.
- PTM dates will be communicated through school website.
